GUIDELINES FOR MID-YEAR ELECTIONS TO FILL REGION NORTH VACANCIES FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN OF STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY OR WITH A 504 PLAN

Eligibility

Must be a parent/guardian of a student with a disability or with a 504 Plan that attends a school in Region North covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Prospective members in the “Parent/Guardian of Student with Exceptional Needs” category will be selected by their peers in accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code 56191.

Length of Term

The Region North representative will complete a 2-year 2024-2026 term left vacant. The alternate will complete a 1-year 2025-2026 term left vacant.
